Times for Rawalpindi (33.57, 73.02), local time, calculated with the University of Islamic Sciences, Karachi method: Fajr at 18°, Maghrib at sunset. Sehri ends at Fajr; many mosques advise stopping about 10 minutes earlier. Ramadan dates follow the Umm al-Qura calendar and are **expected** until the moon is sighted. If Ramadan starts a day later where you are, use the same row for each date: the times depend on the date, not the Ramadan day.
