Times for Sheffield (53.38, -1.47), local time, calculated with the Moonsighting Committee Worldwide method: Fajr at 18° with the seasonal adjustment used for northern latitudes, Maghrib a few minutes after sunset. Sehri ends at Fajr; many mosques advise stopping about 10 minutes earlier. Ramadan dates follow the Umm al-Qura calendar and are **expected** until the moon is sighted. If Ramadan starts a day later where you are, use the same row for each date: the times depend on the date, not the Ramadan day.
